



# Mission Concepts

**Hoping you had a good Thanksgiving!** There is so much to be thankful for but in this letter we want to start with a huge thank you to those who kept us alive and anointed through 14 days of meetings and the travel involved. Nepal is funky, but on the 38 hour trip home we also had a leaky gas tank on our 747 and nearly hit another plane on our approach to San Francisco! Many thanks for your gifts which helped us and the Nepali pastors to create a context people were converted, healed, Spirit filled, and encouraged. All glory to Jesus!

**Hong Kong** The publisher of the Chinese version of my mission's book informed me that 10,000 copies had been printed (over a year ago!) and many already in China.

**Nepal Nov. 1** Our team was in Kathmandu churches Saturday, and then on Sunday we had a 1 day fire of God meeting with a church on the mountain overlooking the valley that leads to Tibet. Several people received Jesus and we all prayed that the Spirit would burn up through that valley.

**Nov. 3** We traveled south 7 hours in vans over the mountains to Hetauda for a 3 day Glory and Fire Revival with pastor J.B. of Eternal Life Church. (Spectacular view of the Himalayas but our dysentery led us to take a 20 minute flight back to the capital after the meetings.) Expecting 300, we had 450 show up. They did a great job to feed these people cooking over a fire. About 100 were filled with the Spirit for the first time. We also had some demons manifest and interesting deliverances.

**Nov. 8** We were back in Kathmandu to speak in churches and then Chris Heian and I jumped in a van to go 5 hours north to Gorka town, the home of the famous Gurka soldiers. Diane and Marilyn Monaghan stay behind to do the women's conference Nov. 9-10. (Both ministries changed their plans if you remember the last letter.)

**Nov. 9-10** Pastor Rajendra's two Gorka Hosanna churches crammed over 200 people in a government auditorium we'd seat about 80. Rajendra had everyone pass by 4 of us for a quick blessing and then out the door. The power of God was so strong 6 women and men fell out manifesting demons and were delivered! We had to move the cooking fire behind the building and they tried to cancel our second day. We had prepaid and prayed so they relented. Here is what the warfare was about: Day 2 - 18 people received Christ, I preached, 6 people gave their testimony, Rajendra preached, they did a drama, Chris preached, Rajendra's father preached, they ordained elders, some of us went 8 miles (13K) down the Mt. to baptize 6 people, and we had a wedding. Then at 2:30PM we traveled by van back to the capital.

**Nov. 11-12** Our team ministered to the pastors some of whom had traveled 24 hrs on the bus. Many were encouraged and a number were filled for the first time.

**Nov. 14** I recorded a radio program for the Christian FM station in Kathmandu. An on-fire young man, raised in a Christian orphanage, has a daily program with 2 days in English. Christianity has amazing freedom now. However, please pray because 3 men are blocking the legalization of Christianity as they construct the new constitution.
